Having knowledge about their methods will help you to be more cautious, therefore when in public fill out documents in a more private area away from prying eyes. It is also important that you avoid keeping certain documents containing your personal information in your wallet instead carry only those documents that you need for the day and preferably in another place other than your wallet. Other criminals break into homes to acquire such information therefore if you are going to be away from some time make sure that you live your alarm system on, alert your neighbors and request them to watch over your house.

Identity thieves may even tap your phone and can pick up your personal information when you are making transactions, others pretend to be representatives of certain legitimate companies and request for your personal information, be careful not to give out any of your personal information to anyone on phone instead tell the caller that you will contact the bank.
